We would like to confirm the dates and details for the four Golf Days arranged this year. This year marks the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our society and there will be an additional event in June to celebrate the special occasion.

**Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> May – Chart Hills**

Coffee & Tea, roll, 18 holes and two course meal after - £105.

**Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June – Seaford Head**

Coffee & Tea, breakfast, 18 holes and meal after - £62.

**Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July – West Kent**

Coffee & Tea, 18 holes and meal after - £72. (£65 without a meal).

**Friday 11<sup>th</sup> September – Cherry Lodge**

Coffee & Tea, 18 holes and meal after - £68. (£62 without a meal).

Tee-time starts are **10.00 a.m.** for Chart Hills and Cherry Lodge and **11.00 a.m.** for Seaford Head and West Kent. Reminders will be sent by WhatsApp approx. 4 weeks before the golf day. Copies of the draw with tee-off times will be messaged a couple of days before the date.

For all golf days, players will play Stableford Bogey using registered WHI's (or internal) as applicable and converted to a playing handicap for the course. Trophy / replica for the winner and replica for runner-up. Prizes up to 5<sup>th</sup> place according to numbers. NP / LD to be advised on the day.

We would welcome existing members to bring a guest along.

Players unable to stop for a meal after golf (West Kent or Cherry Lodge) will have a pre-assigned raffle ticket to go into the draw.
